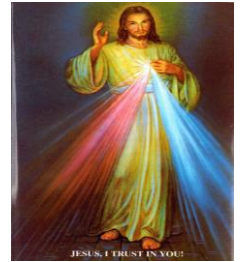
Dear Parishioners
